Appendix

1. NOMINATIONS FOR THE SERVICE AWARD

A nomination must be

- (a) in a form approved by the TSSSA Committee, and
- (b) signed by the principal of the school involved

2. Secondary School Service to Sport Award

The Service Award recognises people who have given an outstanding and highly commendable contribution to secondary school sport in the Taranaki Region, of at least 15 years' duration to a school or sport connected to a school team. The award may be given posthumously.

The criteria for nomination in this category is broad, and in general, over to individual schools as a means of recognising up to 5 individuals who fall within the parameters of this category. The thrust of this category is to recognise those individuals who have made a significant contribution to the betterment of sport in your school and the region by personal commitment, either as an administrator, coach, manager etc. Schools are invited to nominate up to 5 persons who over a time period of at least 15 years, have made a significant contribution to sport at their school. This contribution may have been in any role - coach, manager, administrator, mentor etc. It may be a teacher, parent or a person from the school community. The thrust of the nomination should be the time and commitment contributed by the person, along with outcomes achieved.

The nominee must have a clear affiliation to 'school sport' for the above length of time. It is up to the school/person recommending the nominee to supply as much relative information as possible with the application so that the committee have the best possible information.

Incomplete applications will not be put in front of the committee for approval. We may need to ask for verification of a nominee's service to a school if it has not been provided.

All applications must be supported by current teaching staff of the school involved.
