TIMES:

**DESCRIPTION:** This is a volleyball event offering both high quality competition for those wishing to compete at regionals and a fun event for teams that prefer participation-based volleyball. The Junior Boys Division 1 teams will be playing off for the P.H. Gayton Shield. This is a McKean Shield Challenge Event.

**DIVISIONS** (In Boys & Girls Categories):

**COMPETITIVE:** Strictly competitive for teams aiming to compete at regionals. 6-a-side – 3 sets (25,25,15). This is consistent with the regional tournament and allows teams the best possible preparation. A time limit of 60 minutes will be enforced if any matches have not finished in the allotted time. All teams require 2 members to know how to complete an FIVB scoresheet without teacher supervision. Duty teams require a 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> ref and lines people. Teams will also need to be in clearly numbered uniform **front and back**.

**SOCIAL:** Participation-focused for teams keen to have a go at volleyball in a more social environment. 6-a-side – 25 minute running clock. **PLAYERS UNIFORM NEEDS TO BE NUMBERED.**

**Entries:** If entries exceed expectation then we may need to restrict numbers. TSSSA in conjunction with the RSO reserves the right to shift teams in to the correct grade.

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## HEALTH & SAFETY

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TSSSA always have a first aid kit present at events & TSSSA staff are first aid trained.

All SMS forms are sent to sports coordinators/TIC and are uploaded to the TSSSA website at least two weeks prior to the event.

Health & Safety is a shared responsibility; therefore, it is important that at TSSSA events:

- School representatives are present, supervising their students at the event from start to finish. Ultimately the students are the responsibility of the school, and in the event of an emergency, it will be the responsibility of the school representative to head count their own students.
- School representatives carry a list of participants who are present at the event & also a record of any participant medical conditions.

- Students come prepared in suitable clothing & with sufficient food & water for the activity's duration.
