**ENTRIES:** All riders are entered as individuals for their School. Team points given to top 3 competitors from each school for riders entered in any class. Open to all students enrolled as a bona fide (MOE Approved) (year 9 – 13) full time student at the school for representation for 2020.

**RACE FORMAT:** The organisers reserve the right to change or alter classes if necessary. Some classes may be split start or be combined depending on entry numbers received at close of entries. Weather/time allowing – practice and 3 rounds of racing.

**MINIMUM SAFETY STANDARDS MUST BE ADHERED TO:** Helmet, goggles, body armour with back protection gloves, long pants & boots, as per 8.1, 8.1c and helmets as rule 8i. 2a & 8.2n. Bikes must comply with rule 10. Note no camera helmets are permitted. Refer Chapter 8 MNZ Manual of Motorsport (safety gear) and Chapter 10 (motorcycles technical)

**RISK MANAGEMENT:** The Co-Ordinator/s will manage risk during the event's programmed activities. This does not include transport to and from the venues, leisure activities or accommodation arrangements. Clear instructions to riders will be given about the extent of the Co-Ordinator/s responsibilities at the riders' briefing the morning of the event. Risk Management Plan is available on request.

**ACCIDENTS/FIRST AID:** Trained and qualified medics will be present at the event, but schools/individuals are responsible for their own basic First Aid (including ice)

**FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE -** For reasons for Force Majeure, should a meeting or part of a meeting be cancelled, any entry fee refunds will only be made at the sole discretion of the organisers. The organisers reserve the right to alter the meeting format as deemed necessary

NOTE: All competitors under 16 years requiring a one event licence must have this licence counter signed by a parent/guardian on the day of the event.

Competitive Classes are open to all students (MNZ licenced and unlicenced), if the Officials on the day believe a rider's ability poses a risk to themselves or others then they will be asked to drop down to the applicable class for their age and bike capacity.

Team Points – overall points from the top 3 competitors (competitive classes only) of each School will be combined to calculate the 2020 TSSSA School Motocross Champions. No separate team entries required – to be eligible for a team you must be competing in any and obtain one of the top 3 individual scores for your School.
